ROMANS 7:22-23

22. For I delight in the law of God after the inward man:

23. But I see **<u>another law</u>** in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.

I do not practice what I want to do, but I am doing the very thing I hate [and yielding to my human nature, my worldliness – my sinful capacity].

ROMANS 7:17 [AMP] So now [if that is the case, then] it is no longer I who do it [the disobedient thing which I despise], but the sin [nature] which lives in me.

ROMANS 7:18-19 [AMPC]

18. For I know that nothing good dwells within me, that is, in my flesh. I can will what is right, but I cannot perform it. [I have the intention and urge to do what is right, but no power to carry it out.]. 19. For I fail to practice the good deeds I desire to do, but the evil deeds that I do not desire to do are what I am [ever] doing.

ROMANS 7:20 [AMP]

20. But if I am doing the very thing I do not want to do, I am no longer the one doing it [that is, it is not me that acts], but the sin [nature] which lives in me.

ROMANS 7:21 [KJV]

21. I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me. ROMANS 7:22 [AMP]

22. For I joyfully delight in the law of God in my inner self [with my new nature], ROMANS 7:23-25 [KJV]

23. But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.

24. O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death?

25. I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.

EPHESIANS 4:30

30. And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
