ACTS 5:40b-42

40b. ...and when they had called the apostles, and beaten them, they commanded that they should not speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go. 41. JOSEPH MEETING HIS BRETHREN [56-1230]

...they found a man who was not in their ecclesiastical realm. He'd heard Jesus pronounce these things, and <u>he was getting the job done</u>. He was casting out devils. And Peter and John come to tell him he had to belong to their group or he couldn't do this. "You'll have to follow us and make up with us. We're the church and you got to do it."
