But God Is In Me

JOHN 14:20

20. At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and <u>I in you</u>.

It's pulling the old life out of the man, and <u>injecting the Life of Christ in the believer</u>, and then he becomes a new creation. He's a new creature.

THE UNCERTAIN SOUND [60-1218] And someday you're going to find out, <u>God is</u> <u>in you</u> (See?), <u>God Himself in the human being. God in us</u>.

I CORINTHIANS 3:16

16. Know ye not that *ye are the temple of God*, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?

BEHOLD A GREATER THAN SOLOMON IS HERE [62-0612]

You are God's letter, a written epistle. <u>God is in you, manifesting Himself through</u>. If you could prostrate yourself before God, and say, "God, I'm a sinner. Come into me," and <u>then the Holy Spirit comes in, and then you're a living idol of God, living</u> <u>representative of God, walking around with God speaking through your lips to</u> <u>others</u>.

God in you. So many wants to point God to some mystical something way away, or so far away they overreach it. <u>God is in you</u>. The hope of Glory, Christ, the mind that was in Christ, in you. You're reaching plumb away from it, trying to get what's been given to you. <u>God, in the human being</u>!

II CORINTHIANS 5:18-20

18. And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and <u>hath</u> *given to us the ministry of reconciliation*;

19. To wit, that <u>**God** was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself</u>, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.

20. *Now then we are ambassadors for Christ*, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.

LET US SEE GOD [59-1129]

God is in you. <u>God, the Holy Spirit is in you</u>, moving around now, <u>reconciling the</u> <u>world to Himself</u>. What makes these inspired ministers preach the Gospel? What makes them? Perhaps one time drunkards; one time gamblers; one time bad men; all of a sudden something changed. And here they stand, preaching the Gospel and giving their lives out.

LET US SEE GOD [59-1129]

<u>It's God in His people</u>. No matter how much it would be in me; it has to be in you too. Because it won't work just by me by myself. It takes you and I together to do it (That's right.): all of us together, God in us all. God, not only in Methodist or Baptist, or Pentecostal, or Presbyterian, but God's in every believer that's received the Holy Ghost. **That's God, the Holy Ghost, in the people reconciling the world to Himself**.

PERSEVERANCE [62-0218]

...God brings His Spirit into you and **you're His living representative**. See, **God's in you, reconciling the world to Himself**.

PHILIPPIANS 2:13

13. For *it is God which worketh in you* both to will and to do of his good pleasure.

THE INSIDE MAN [53-1212]

Now, in you is God. You who have the Holy Ghost, God is in you. Do you believe that? And now, Jesus said, "*I give you power*." Let me show you the weakness of the church by God's grace. "*I give you power over unclean spirits*. You'll cast them out." <u>Not I</u> will, you will. "You'll cast… In My Name they shall cast out devils. They shall speak with new tongues. They take up serpents, they drink deadly things, it will not harm them."

<u>JOHN 15:7</u>

7. If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, <u>ye shall ask what ye will</u>, and it shall be done unto you.

Jesus said, "Whatever you ask the Father in My Name, that will I do."
