God's Testimony Pt2

GENESIS 4:3-7

And in process of time it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the LORD.
And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering:
But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wroth, and his countenance fell.
And the LORD said unto Cain, Why art thou wroth? and why is thy countenance fallen?
If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee shall be his desire, and thou shalt rule over him.

THE POWER OF GOD [55-1006E] The Bible wasn't written then. So if Cain, his brother who set under the same teaching of father and mother, came down and brought fruit to make the offering... But Abel, by revelation he saw that it wasn't fruits that brought us out of the garden of Eden, as some people still think it was. But it wasn't fruits. It was the blood of his mother who made him mortal, or his father. So he came and offered the blood of a lamb by Divine revelation. No one to tell him anything about it, but he, by faith he seen the Son of God coming, and offered a lamb in a figurative type, seeing that Jesus was the Lamb slain before the foundation of the world. <u>And God testified,</u> <u>"That's the truth." God will always testify the truth</u>.

GENESIS 4:8-10

8. And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him. 9. And the LORD said unto Cain, Where is Abel thy brother? And he said, I know not: Am I my brother's keeper? 10. And he said, What hast thou done? <u>the voice of thy brother's blood crieth unto me from the ground</u>.

HEBREWS 11:4

4. By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, <u>God testifying of his gifts</u>: and by it he being dead yet speaketh.

THE ANGEL OF THE LORD [53-0604]

Hebrews 11:2 said, "*God testifies of His gifts*." A man can say most anything, and I will admit that there's been much said in the Name of the Lord that is not of the Lord. But <u>God would never testify or a vindicate a lie. God will always vindicate truth and</u> <u>never a lie</u>. God is not an author of lies and confusion. He's the Author of peace, and truth, and holiness, and righteousness, peace. <u>God always testifies of the truth</u>.

IDENTIFICATION [63-0123]

When Cain offered the fruits of the field, as apples and the fruits, and so forth, and made his altar pretty, and said, "God will accept this because I've done all this, and fixed the great altars. And I've decorated. I made it pretty. We got the biggest church in the city, or so forth. God will accept it, in this." <u>He accepts the work of no man's hands, in redemption</u>.

But Abel brought a lamb and offered blood, and <u>God testified that he was righteous</u>. How did he know it? <u>There was no Word written in them days. It was a revelation</u>, <u>and so is it today</u>.

You say, "Well, I belong to church. My church is as good as your church. They're both made out of the same kind of building, same kind of materials." That's right. <u>The</u> **building has nothing to do with it**.

Organization is a group of men who gets together, make up a decalogue of what they stand for, and that's it. Nothing against that, that's all right, but that ain't what I'm talking about. You wear the same kind of clothes, maybe, if they're decent, what other believers would do, and still that doesn't make it.

But now looky here. <u>What it is, is the spiritual revelation of the Word of God. That,</u> <u>everything else is wrong but that Word</u>, and you believe It. He was the Word, and He is the Word, and He will always be the Word. <u>And when God can open that channel</u>, <u>then He can flow freely through that sanctified body</u>.

IT SHALL BE EVEN AS IT WAS TOLD ME [50-0818]

Anyone can say anything they wish to. And they can have impressions. But when God really sends something, He will vindicate that to be the truth. See? <u>God will speak</u> <u>of it</u>. The Bible said in Hebrews, "*God testifying of His gifts…*" Hebrews 11:10. Is that right? <u>God testifying, then you got God's testimony</u>. The Holy Spirit is the gift of God.

THE MINISTRY EXPLAINED [56-1001] You don't believe the Holy Spirit is a gift of God, let It come on you one time. God will testify of His gifts.

EXHORTATION OF DIVINE HEALING [51-0501]

<u>God sends some of us forth to do certain things</u>. And then we see that God has proved what He said He was to that person, and then God testifies the thing the person testified of. That makes it truth, and t<u>hen we believe it and get well</u>.

FAITH WITHOUT WORKS IS DEAD [50-0822]

Now, gifts come from God. <u>If they are from God, they'll testify of God. And God</u> <u>will testify of them</u>.

FAITH IS THE SUBSTANCE [47-0412]

I was going into the drug store. And when I went in, I noticed some fellow looking at me kind of strangely. I went on in the store, and I come back out, and I had the bottle cap. And I never forgot about him. And I was still had my uniform on.

And he put his... The man put his hand on my shoulder, and he looked at me; he said, "Sir," said, "I seen you was an officer." Said, "I thought I'd ask you a question." Said, "You may think I'm kind of crazy."

And I said, "What's the matter, sir?"

He said, "I live in Paducah, Kentucky." He said, "I've been failing in health for about two years." He said, "Last week I had a peculiar dream." FAITH IS THE SUBSTANCE [47-0412] <u>God will testify of it. His works will be</u> <u>declared, regardless of what people think about it</u>. That's right.
