God's Testimony Pt3

<u>I KINGS 17:1</u>

1. And Elijah the Tishbite, who was of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, As the LORD God of Israel liveth, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word.

GET THE PEOPLE TO BELIEVE [52-0717]

If a man testifies, you have a right to doubt that (See?), or not doubt it, but to watch it. And then <u>if God testifies to the same thing, that it's absolutely the truth, then that's</u> <u>not the man's testimony, that's God confirming that testimony</u>.

<u>I KINGS 17:13-16</u>

13. And Elijah said unto her, <u>Fear not</u>; go and do as thou hast said: but make me thereof a little cake first, and bring it unto me, and after make for thee and for thy son.

14. For thus saith the LORD God of Israel, The barrel of meal shall not waste, neither shall the cruse of oil fail, until the day that the LORD sendeth rain upon the earth.

15. And she went and did according to the saying of Elijah: and she, and he, and her house, did eat many days. 16. And the barrel of meal wasted not, neither did the cruse of oil fail, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by Elijah.

<u>I KINGS 17:21-24</u>

21. And he stretched himself upon the child three times, and cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, I pray thee, let this child's soul come into him again.

22. And <u>the LORD heard the voice of Elijah</u>; and the soul of the child came into him again, and he revived. 23. And Elijah took the child, and brought him down out of the chamber into the house, and delivered him unto his mother: and Elijah said, See, thy son liveth.

24. And the woman said to Elijah, Now by this I know that thou art a man of God, and that <u>the</u> *word of the LORD in thy mouth is truth*.

<u>I KINGS 18:21</u>

21. And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, <u>How long halt ye between two opinions</u>? *if the LORD be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him. And the people answered him not a word.*

<u>I KINGS 18:24</u>

24. And call ye on the name of your gods, and I will call on the name of the LORD: and the God that answereth by fire, let him be God. And all the people answered and said, It is well spoken.

<u>I KINGS 18:41-44</u>

41. And Elijah said unto Ahab, Get thee up, eat and drink; for <u>there is a sound of abundance</u> <u>of rain</u>. 42. So Ahab went up to eat and to drink. And Elijah went up to the top of Carmel; and he cast himself down upon the earth, and put his face between his knees,

43. And said to his servant, Go up now, look toward the sea. And he went up, and looked, and said, There is nothing. And he said, Go again seven times.

44. And it came to pass at <u>the seventh time</u>, that he said, Behold, there ariseth <u>a little cloud</u> <u>out of the sea, like a man's hand</u>. And he said, Go up, say unto Ahab, Prepare thy chariot, and get thee down, that the rain stop thee not.

FAITH IS THE SUBSTANCE [47-0412]

Right in the days of Elijah there raised up false prophets, but <u>God testified of the</u> prophecy of Elijah. If it's of God, God will testify of it.

I KINGS 21:19b

19b. Thus saith the LORD, In the place where dogs licked the blood of Naboth shall dogs lick thy blood, even thine.

I KINGS 21:23

23. And of Jezebel also spake the LORD, saying, The dogs shall eat Jezebel by the wall of Jezreel.

HEAR YE HIM [57-0105]

You can say what you want to. If God doesn't testify, you have the right to doubt it. But <u>if God testifies that's what's been said is the truth, then the doubt makes you a</u> <u>sinner</u>. I don't care where you go or how much religion you claim to have, you're an unbeliever. Caiaphas was an unbeliever, religious.

<u>I KINGS 22:11-12</u>

And Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah made him horns of iron: and he said, Thus saith the LORD, With these shalt thou push the Syrians, until thou have consumed them.
And all the prophets prophesied so, saying, Go up to Ramothgilead, and prosper: for the

LORD shall deliver it into the king's hand.

GOD IN HIS PEOPLE [50-0227]

And everything that we do must purely be of the Scripture. If it isn't a Scripture background, then it isn't right. But anything that's based upon the Scripture is--you can listen to it. And <u>if it's God, God will testify of it. If it isn't God, then God will not</u> <u>testify</u>. Just the men will testify and God will not. But if it be God, <u>God will testify for</u> <u>Himself</u>.

I KINGS 22:17

17. And he said, I saw all Israel scattered upon the hills, as sheep that have not a shepherd: and the LORD said, These have no master: let them return every man to his house in peace.

I KINGS 22:24-25

24. But Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah went near, and smote Micaiah on the cheek, and said, Which way went the Spirit of the LORD from me to speak unto thee? 25. And Micaiah said, Behold, thou shalt see in that day, when thou shalt go into an inner chamber to hide thyself.

THE ANGEL OF THE LORD [51-0502]

And if I tell the truth, then God will testify that I've told the truth.

EXPERIENCES [52-0726]

If I make a statement, and God has told me to do so, then God will back it up.

THE RESURRECTION OF JAIRUS DAUGHTER [54-0302]

Believe, no matter comes or goes, believe anyhow. Now, if I tell the truth, <u>God will</u> testify of the truth. God will never testify to an error. It'll always testify of truth.

BE NOT AFRAID, IT IS I [62-0629]

And I said, "I don't claim to be a god. I don't claim to be a healer. I--I claim to be the servant of Christ. If I--I only say if this ministry is in question, let God testify for Himself."

And here It come whirling down through the meeting before thousands times thousands of people, and <u>the critics took the picture of It</u>.

MOSES [50-0110]

Now, what I tell you tonight, I want each one of you to remember just what I telled you. And then, if those things doesn't happen just the way I say they are, then when the service is over, at the end of these seventeen days, you can go around town and say, "Brother Branham is a false prophet." But if God testifies back just exactly what I say is the truth, well then, you believe God if you don't believe me. Isn't that right? Then you can go around and say the Lord is right, the Lord has told us the truth.

FAITH IS THE SUBSTANCE [47-0412]

And if I tell you about a gift of Divine healing and God doesn't testify of it, leave it go; it's wrong. But **<u>if God testifies of it</u>**, **<u>believe it's God's gift to you</u>**.
