AS I THOUGHT ON MY WAY [59-0610]

What the Church needs tonight is a confession and making right to come back to <u>the</u> <u>testimonies of the Lord God</u>. There's mercy, forgiveness. Seems that it would haunt people, going on, know that you're walking hour by hour in the face of death. Why do we continue on with selfishness, and greed, and ungodliness, and--and our eyes on things of the world? <u>It's time we turn back to God's testimonies</u>.

PSALM 119:97-99

97. O how love I thy law! it is my meditation all the day.

98. Thou through thy commandments hast made me wiser than mine enemies: for they are ever with me.

99. I have more understanding than all my teachers: for *thy testimonies* are my meditation.

And any Word that God says, It can never be changed. Now that's the reason I believe the Bible is just the way It's written. See, <u>It can never be changed. We can't find</u> <u>nothing better</u>...

PSALM 119:111

111. <u>*Thy testimonies*</u> have I taken as an heritage for ever: for they are the rejoicing of my heart.

THE TOKEN [64-0208]

I don't care what the people says. If the Word of God says it, and promised it, I believe it. <u>If the Word says it, that settles it. I don't care what anybody else says</u>.

EPHESIANS 4:14

14. That we henceforth be no more children, **[tossed] to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine**, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive;

GOD'S PREPARATION [54-0401]

When you go through temptation, just hold your ground. If somebody says, "Well, now, you're all off the track." <u>Stay right where you're at till God says it. Don't shake</u> <u>at every wind</u>. See? Stay right there. You know, men, that God... Even if you're a little out of the way, if you'll really, in your heart, be sincere and stand firm on what you believe, God will respect it. That's right.

THE TRUE VINE AND A FALSE VINE [55-0607]

You believe God's Bible; that's the thing that's right. "*Let ever man words be a lie; let Mine be the true,*" God says, no matter what it is. And the proof of the pudding is (as the old slogan is), is the eating thereof. <u>If God says it in His Word, and He produces it,</u> <u>believe it, and go on. Forget the rest of it, and just let God be truth</u>.

A GREATER THAN SOLOMON IS HERE [61-0412]

If the man preaches anything that's contrary and not found in the Word of God, then I'll leave it alone. <u>But if he preaches what's in the Word</u>, and God comes back and vindicates by the Urim sign that it's the truth, <u>then that's God witnessing that that is</u> <u>right. To disbelieve that is to be doomed</u>.

MARY'S BELIEF [61-0121]

Now, then <u>if one speaks and it's not Scriptural</u>, <u>don't believe it</u>. <u>If he speaks and it</u> <u>is Scriptural</u>, <u>wait a minute</u>. <u>Try it with the Urim and Thummim</u>. <u>Then if the</u> <u>supernatural answers back that it is the truth</u>, <u>then believe it</u>. <u>That's the way to</u> <u>believe a true message</u>.

If the Bible promises anything and the Bible says it's so, that's God's Urim and Thummim. If the preacher preaches... preaching, like the Bible said, that's God's messenger, God's witness. Then if it is, then the supernatural of that Word will be made manifest and prove itself to be God. God keeps His promise.
