#### **JAMES 2:19**

## THE INTER VEIL [56-0121]

And there, she in that state, but <u>the intellectuals begin to fail</u>, when the reasonings failed, her <u>intellectual faith that she had in God</u>, which was in her head, then that soul that she had grieved away begin to come up close her. She said, "My God, I'm lost! I'm lost!"

## ENTICING SPIRITS [55-0724]

Hope's one thing; faith is another. Hope hopes for it. Faith has got it. <u>One's</u> intellectual faith, and the other is direct revelation of God.

## THE FAITH THAT WAS ONCE DELIVERED TO THE SAINTS [55-0501E]

... <u>faith is not something mentally perceived, but it is a revelation</u>, a revelation of God, by faith, not intellectual, but by his heart.

#### THE ANOINTED ONES AT THE END TIME [65-0725M]

What is faith? Faith is something that's revealed to you; that is not yet, but you believe it will be. **Faith is a revelation of the will of God**. So, by revelation!

#### WORKS IS FAITH EXPRESSED [65-1126]

Now, I can't make you believe, neither can you make yourself believe. God has got to give it to you. It's a gift of God, to believe. Not your faith, God's faith. Your intellectual faith might believe it fine, but unless the faith of God is down in your heart... See, your intellectual faith can accept it, do that. And just keep believing it with all your heart until God does reveal it to you. See? Just keep believing it until God does reveal it.

#### THE FAITH THAT WAS ONCE DELIVERED TO THE SAINTS [55-0501E]

## PROOF OF HIS RESURRECTION [55-0410M]

They believed once in the natural. But when a little trial come up, it all went to pieces. Now, here, I don't aim to hurt you, but I want to correct you. See? That just shows when a man only has <code>intellectual faith</code> by saying, "Yes, that's the Word of God. Yeah, I believe God rose up Jesus on today." Then that, if that's all you've got, the first little discouragement comes up in your church, away you go, go on out. See? <code>You might be a friend to Him, but you don't know Him in the power of His resurrection</code>.

## WHO IS THIS? [59-1004M]

You can't understand God by <u>intellectual faith</u>; you must be borned again. It's got to come to the heart. It's got to be an experience. And when the experience is wrought by the Holy Spirit, then the same nature, and the same power, and the same reaction that happened on the Church first will come again, for <u>It's God in them</u>.

## EXPECTATION [55-1001]

Now, your <u>intellectual faith</u> will reason. You'll say, "Now, I know the Bible teaches that, certainly. But let me think now, the days of miracles is past. Pastor said so, somebody said so. I--I believe that this day we don't have that." Now, see, you're using <u>intellectual faith</u>. And that <u>intellectual faith will reason with God's Word</u>, but a borned again experience from the heart will not reason; it will say, "<u>God's Word's right</u>. There's no more to do with it; it's right." Because something down here that says it Itself; you have nothing to do with it. It's God in the heart.
