JEREMIAH 18:1-6

- 1. The word which came to Jeremiah from the LORD, saying,
- 2. Arise, and go down to the potter's house, and there I will cause thee to hear my words.
- 3. Then I went down to the potter's house, and, behold, he wrought a work on the wheels.
- 4. And the vessel that he made of clay was marred in the hand of the potter: so <u>he made it</u> again another vessel, as seemed good to the potter to make it.
- 5. Then the word of the LORD came to me, saying,
- 6. O house of Israel, cannot I do with you as this potter? saith the LORD. Behold, as the clay is in the potter's hand, so are ye in mine hand, O house of Israel.

TIME TESTED MEMORIALS OF GOD [57-0818]

Long years ago before they had the smelters, they used to take the gold, and how they would know how it was right or not, with all the sludge was out of it, all of the iron pyrite (that's fools gold), all the fools out of it, they--beaters beat it, and beat it, and turned it, and beat it, and turned it until the beater sees his reflection in the gold.

That's the way God does His church. He gives you trial after trial, test after test, trial after trial, test after test, <u>until the life of Christ is reflected in your life</u>, until you become peaceful, sober, meek, gentle, humble, ready, submissive, willing, turn your head from the things of the world and looking straight to Calvary to the One Who's doing the beating.
