JOHN 14:12

12. *Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.*

GOD'S WORD CALLS FOR A TOTAL SEPARATION FROM UNBELIEF [64-0121]

The question is, to the people today, "Does He really mean it?" And when you accept what the church says, "Does He really mean it?" then you put yourself in the same condition that Adam did, and join yourself with the--the woman of the church of the--this world, and separate yourself from **the blessings that God has promised to every believer** that would separate himself from the world to the Word.

CHRIST IS THE MYSTERY OF GOD REVEALED [63-0728]

The Bible said He is the same! Saint John 5, or Saint John 14:12, He said, "he," **he, anybody.** "*He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also.*"

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS 3 [64-0830M]

Q373. *Will every true believer do the works that Jesus said, as stated in St. John 14:12 (Not exactly. No.): heal the sick, cast out devils, raise the dead (I don't think that's in St. John 14, but it's all right. It's Mark 16.), or--or are--**is this only to be Elijah?** Must the believer do all that--of this--do really--that really believe? And if he really is a real believer, will he raise the dead and do great miracles?*

Now, that is among the believers. See? Every man doesn't have those gifts, and don't mean that just one person will do it; there'll be groups of people. Like for instance, what if--if we had a little girl here in the church, or a little boy, or somebody that we love real well, and life would go out of them. The whole church would get together, and they'd go to pray and fasting: "Lord, have mercy on that child." See? God could raise it up.

How many ever read the Nicene Fathers and them? You know, that's the way they did it in the early church. They'd all get together, you know, and even raise up their pastor sometime and different ones like that, if God seen fit to do it; but they did it.

INVESTMENTS [63-0803B]

Because, God is in the--the believer just like He was in Christ. Not in the fulness He was in Christ, but He is in you just like He was, because you are a son of God through Jesus Christ.

THE SPOKEN WORD IS THE ORIGINAL SEED [62-0318]

Tell me where the Head ever said, "*These works I do, but you shall not do them.*" Tell me that. But, the Head said this. You want to put the Scripture down, I'll give it to you. John 14:12, "*The works that I do shall you also,*" **that's His Body**. See? See now why I have been so zealous of the--the kind of Seed that I planted for the Body?

THE SPOKEN WORD IS THE ORIGINAL SEED [62-0318]

What is it? **Same Seed**.

JEHOVAH JIREH PT2 [62-0706]

And **that same Life that was lived in Christ Jesus has to be lived in the covenant people, same Life doing the same thing**. Jesus said in John 14:12, "*He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he also.*" Now, that's either right or wrong. It's got to be right! To me, every Word of It is right. Every Word is perfectly right. Notice how glorious God works.

PERSEVERANCE [62-0218]

You can make It, twist It around and try to make It say something, but still It remains the same. **And you watch anybody that's got faith enough to believe that, It'll manifest Itself the same way that God did it.**

JEHOVAH JIREH [57-0612]

That was His eternal promise to His church. "*The works that I do, shall you also. Greater works than this will you do, for I go unto My Father.*" What a promise. Wonderful.

PRESUMING [62-0117]

Brother, there's no presuming on that, not a thing. He said that ye shall do it.

TO TAKE ON THE WHOLE ARMOR OF GOD [62-0701]

John 14:12, Jesus said, "*He that believeth in Me, the works that I do shall he do also.*" **What is it? It's God in the church in these five predestinated offices, backing up every Word that He said** with the Holy Spirit Himself in there, which is the Word made manifest, proving His resurrection, proving that He lives.

PERSEVERANT [64-0305]

...He is here in the form of the Holy Ghost, to come into me and into you, and perform His same works.

PERSEVERANCE [62-0608]

And **if these words are true, He's appearing in human flesh. Then you let Him appear in your flesh**, giving you faith in His promised Word, Saint John 14:12, "*The works that I do shall you also.*"

THAT DAY ON CALVARY [60-0925]

Now, notice, **the greater works was to have the power in the church, not only to heal the sick by prayer, cast out devils by prayer, but to impart Eternal Life to believers. The Holy Ghost was coming and given into the hands of the church to impart life. Oh, that's what Calvary meant.**

It took stooped, degraded men and women and lifted them into a place to be sons and daughters of God to heal the sick and to impart Eternal Life. By giving the Holy Ghost to obedient believers, men who were once unbelievers be made believers and impart spiritual Eternal Life.

Now if we're at the last end of the age, where is them "greater works" going to come? See? See? We're here.

GOD'S GIFTS ALWAYS FIND THEIR PLACES [63-1222]

Notice, now, **that was the Son of God promising to the believer, that greater things than He did, (in these last days) that the believer would do greater things than He did.** Saint John, 14th chapter, 12th verse. Is that right? Do you believe Jesus said it?

CHURCH AGE BOOK

Oh, **if the church could only get a fresh revelation and become by it the living Word manifested, we would do the greater works** and glorify God our Father in heaven.

CHURCH AGE BOOK [NB note: "*Satan hates revelation*".]

He knows that if the people get the TRUE REVELATION of the TRUE CHURCH and what she is, what she stands for and that **SHE CAN DO THE GREATER WORKS**, she will be an invincible army. If they get a true revelation of the two spirits within the framework of the Christian church, and by God's Spirit discern and withstand the antichrist spirit, Satan will be powerless before her.
