- 30. And Jesus, immediately knowing in himself that virtue had gone out of him, turned him about in the press, and said, Who touched my clothes?

- 16. And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?
- 17. If the whole body were an eye, where were the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where were the smelling?
- 18. But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.

- 20. But now are they many members, yet but one body.
