Reflecting Jesus

JOHN 14:20

20. At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.

HEBREWS 1:3b

3b. ...the express image of his person...

II CORINTHIANS 5:19b

19b. ... God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself.

COLOSSIANS 1:19

19. For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell;

COLOSSIANS 2:9

9. For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

THE WORLD IS FALLING APART [63-1115]

God over us, God with us, now God in us. All that God was, He poured into Christ; all that Christ was, He poured into the Church. "At that day, you'll know that I am in the Father, the Father in Me; I in you, and you in Me." So it's been God all along, you see, His same works. The Church is ordained to carry on His work, with the same Spirit. You couldn't carry on the same work without the same Spirit. That's right. The same Spirit carries on the work.

ACTS 4:13

13. Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that **they had been with Jesus**.

LET US SEE GOD [59-1129]

Who was it, that when Saint Peter, the apostle, a fisherman so ignorant... The Bible said, "He was ignorant and unlearned." Who was it, when he walked down along the streets, and people laid the sick in the shadow of that man, and they were healed? Was it a man's shadow that healed them? It was God in His people that did the healing.

Who was it in Saint Paul, when they took from his body handkerchiefs or aprons, and laid on the sick? God was in His people. They recognized God in Saint Paul.

HEAR YE HIM [60-0806]

...the reflection of Jesus Christ comes back into the church, that the church can see Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today, and forever, till we can see the reflection, the church moving in the power of God, just like Jesus was here on earth. <u>He's reflecting</u> Himself in the church.

IMAGES OF CHRIST [59-0525]

...the word "Christian" means "Christ-like," and to reflect Him. Now, that doesn't mean that we have to grow a long beard, as the artist pictures Him having. And neither does it mean that we grow long hair as the artist pictures Him having, or to wear robe as He wore; for we're living in another day. We don't necessarily have to be that to reflect His physical image; but we must, in our souls, reflect His Spirit image and His manner of life.

I do not believe that Christians consist of joining churches or creeds. I believe it's <u>a</u> <u>reflection of Jesus Christ in a human being</u>.

SIRS WE WOULD SEE JESUS [57-0226]

See? We'll do the same works, think the same thoughts, live the same type of life. If the Spirit of God is in you, it makes you live like Christ, Christ-like.
