## MATTHEW 2:11

11. *And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother, and fell down, and worshipped him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts; gold, and frankincense, and myrrh.*

## EXODUS 4:1-2

1. *And Moses answered and said, But, behold, they will not believe me, nor hearken unto my voice: for they will say, The LORD hath not appeared unto thee.*

2. *And the LORD said unto him, **What is that in thine hand?** And he said, A rod.*

## I KINGS 17:5-16

5. *So he went and did according unto the word of the LORD: for he went and dwelt by the brook Cherith, that is before Jordan.*

6. *And the ravens brought him bread and flesh in the morning, and bread and flesh in the evening; and he drank of the brook.*

7. *And it came to pass after a while, that the brook dried up, because there had been no rain in the land.*

8. *And the word of the LORD came unto him, saying,*

9. *Arise, get thee to Zarephath, which belongeth to Zidon, and dwell there: behold, I have commanded a widow woman there to sustain thee.*

10. *So he arose and went to Zarephath. And when he came to the gate of the city, behold, the widow woman was there gathering of sticks: and he called to her, and said, Fetch me, I pray thee, a little water in a vessel, that I may drink.*

11. *And as she was going to fetch it, he called to her, and said, Bring me, I pray thee, a morsel of bread in thine hand.*

12. *And she said, As the LORD thy God liveth, I have not a cake, but an handful of meal in a barrel, and a little oil in a cruse: and, behold, I am gathering two sticks, that I may go in and dress it for me and my son, that we may eat it, and die.*

13. *And Elijah said unto her, Fear not; go and do as thou hast said: but make me thereof a little cake first, and bring it unto me, and after make for thee and for thy son.*

14. *For thus saith the LORD God of Israel, The barrel of meal shall not waste, neither shall the cruse of oil fail, until the day that the LORD sendeth rain upon the earth.*

15. *And she went and did according to the saying of Elijah: and she, and he, and her house, did eat many days.*

16. *And the barrel of meal wasted not, neither did the cruse of oil fail, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by Elijah.*

### **JOHN 6:8-9**

8. *One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, saith unto him,*

9. *There is a lad here, which hath five barley loaves, and two small fishes: but what are they among so many?*

### **AN EXODUS [56-0615]**
