Reflecting His Word

HEBREWS 10:1

1. For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect.

GENESIS 4:10b ...the voice of thy brother's blood crieth unto me from the ground.

HEBREWS 12:24

24. And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel.

THE TOKEN [64-0308] We find out, the Blood does speak, It speaks in your behalf. The Life that's in you speaks from the shed Blood. Amen. Oh, brother! I wish everybody could see that. See? If you can see what it is, it's the Life that's in you. See, that Blood is identifying you with It. It's the Token.

JOHN 3:14

And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up:

JOHN 12:32 *And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men unto me.*

HE SWORE BY HIMSELF [54-1212] ...the brass serpent was, was a reflection of Jesus Christ in sin already judged in Divine judgment...

DOCTOR MOSES [55-0114]

In the mind of God, Christ was already crucified. For He was the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world. Back in Eden, Christ in God's thoughts, which became His Word, had not yet materialized. But He knew it was, for He had promised it. And He let the children of Israel draw interest before the deposit was made.

HOSEA 11:1 *When Israel was a child, then I loved him, and called my son out of Egypt.*

JOHN 1:1

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

JOHN 1:14a *And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us,*

WHY IT HAD TO BE SHEPHERD [64-1221]

God was made flesh and dwelt among us. That's... The Bible said, "*In the beginning of the creation of God.*" **God was created in human form; in Jesus Christ**, His Son, God dwelt. He built His tabernacle of flesh and bones, and lived in that tabernacle; God, Emmanuel, "*God with us.*" He built Himself a house, to live in it, so He could reflect His Word to His subjects through that. **You know what God is, when you see Christ.**

THE INDICTMENT [63-0707M]

Jesus Christ was the Person, Man, God. Hallelujah. **He was the manifestation of God. He was God in a body form**, to reflect the Word of God for that age, to make that age see God's promise for that age. And the Holy Ghost is the same thing today. **It's the Spirit of God upon the written Word, trying to find somebody to reflect Itself to this age**, to prove that He's the same yesterday, today, and forever.

EZEKIEL 2:8-9

8. But thou, son of man, hear what I say unto thee; Be not thou rebellious like that rebellious house: open thy mouth, and eat that I give thee. 9. And when I looked, behold, an hand was sent unto me; and, lo, a [roll] of a book was therein;

EZEKIEL 3:3b *Then did I eat it; and it was in my mouth as honey for sweetness.*

REVELATION 10:10-11

10. And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter. 11. And he said unto me, Thou must prophesy again before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings.

GOD'S ONLY PROVIDED PLACE OF WORSHIP [65-1128M]

You are a reflector, that's the reason the prophet had to eat the book. That's the reason he had to eat the scroll. **He had to reflect that Word for that age.**

HEBREWS CHAPTERS 5&6 PT1 [57-0908M]

Don't try to have any sensation or anything to take the place of the Holy Spirit. When the new Birth is come, you are changed. You don't have to do anything to prove it. Your life proves it, as you walk. You're love, peace, long-suffering, gentleness, meekness, patience. That's what you are, and **the whole world sees the reflection of Jesus Christ in you.**

II CORINTHIANS 3:2-3

2. *Ye are our epistle* written in our hearts, ***known and read of all men:***
3. *Forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone, but in fleshy tables of the heart.*

THE HARVEST TIME [64-1212]. ...**you're a written Bible reflecting His Word...**

THE HARVEST TIME [64-1212] There is **the real Spirit-filled Church** now, stays with the Word, **reflects the Word, God on earth.**

THE IDENTIFIED MASTERPIECE OF GOD [64-1205] You've got to stay with that Word, to be the Bride. If you're in the Bride, you're in the Word, and the Word is in you. And **the Word that reflected God through Christ, reflects the same God through you.**

IDENTIFICATION [63-0123] ...we are a written epistle, **a looking glass, that people can see Christ in us.** And now, if they don't, then we're--we're--we're looking at something else, and we're not looking to Him.

THE HARVEST TIME [64-1212] See, it doesn't reflect the Word when anybody says, "Well, That was for another age," 'cause the Bible said He's the same yesterday, today, and forever.

IDENTIFICATION [63-0123]

And then **the Word becomes a living thing, It just expresses Itself through you.** See? Then you're looking in the looking glass, when people sees you as a mirror. Because, you know, God has made a way. **People won't read the Bible, so God has made you a Bible.** You are. What you do, people is looking at you.

GOD'S WORD CALLS FOR A TOTAL SEPARATION FROM UNBELIEF [64-0121]

And as husband and wife is one, so does the Bride and the Word become One, for **the Word is living through the Bride.** That's how. **That's her credentials. That's her identification.**

COMMUNION [63-0707E] **May we live such holy, consecrated life after this, that men will see the reflection of Jesus Christ in us,** and that our--our walk in life would be worthy of the Gospel that we believe.
