Wisdom Pt2

I CHRONICLES 22:7-12

7. And David said to Solomon, My son, as for me, it was in my mind to build an house unto the name of the LORD my God: 8. But the word of the LORD came to me, saying, Thou hast shed blood abundantly, and hast made great wars: thou shalt not build an house unto my name, because thou hast shed much blood upon the earth in my sight. 9. Behold, a son shall be born to thee, who shall be a man of rest; and I will give him rest from all his enemies round about: for his name shall be Solomon, and I will give peace and quietness unto Israel in his days. 10. He shall build an house for my name; and he shall be my son, and I will be his father; and I will establish the throne of his kingdom over Israel for ever. 11. Now, my son, the LORD be with thee; and prosper thou, and build the house of the LORD thy God, as he hath said of thee. 12. Only **the LORD give thee wisdom and understanding**, and give thee charge concerning Israel, that thou mayest keep the law of the LORD thy God.

GOD KEEPS HIS WORD [57-0407M] **The first gift in the line of gifts is wisdom.** The second is knowledge. And if you don't have any wisdom, how do you know what to do with knowledge. **Seek the best things first: wisdom;** and if you hadn't got wisdom, what can you do with knowledge, or speaking with tongues, or these other things? It takes wisdom. **It takes God's wisdom.**

II CHRONICLES 1:6-9 [NB note: Tabernacle in the wilderness at Gibeon]

6. And Solomon went up thither to the brasen altar before the LORD, which was at the tabernacle of the congregation, and offered a thousand burnt offerings upon it. 7. In that night did God appear unto Solomon, and said unto him, **Ask what I shall give thee.** 8. And Solomon said unto God, Thou hast shewed great mercy unto David my father, and hast made me to reign in his stead. 9. Now, O LORD God, let thy promise unto David my father be established: for thou hast made me king over a people like the dust of the earth in multitude. 10. **Give me now wisdom and knowledge,** that I may go out and come in before this people: for who can judge this thy people, that is so great? 11. And God said to Solomon, Because this was in thine heart, and thou hast not asked riches, wealth, or honour, nor the life of thine enemies, neither yet hast asked long life; but hast asked wisdom and knowledge for thyself, that thou mayest judge my people, over whom I have made thee king: 12. Wisdom and knowledge is granted unto thee; and I will give thee riches, and wealth, and honour, such as none of the kings have had that have been before thee, neither shall there any after thee have the like.

LEAN NOT UNTO THY OWN UNDERSTANDING [65-0120] Solomon was a man borned of a woman and was begotten by an earthly father, David. But Jesus was a virgin-born Son, and was not altogether a man; but He was God, the God-Man, and He was more than a man, He was a Man, plus. See? **But Solomon was just a man like you and I, and he asked God for wisdom, to run his kingdom. And he had a gift of wisdom, the smartest man that we've ever known of outside of our Lord.**

JAMES 1:5

5. *If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.*

THE MINISTRY EXPLAINED [56-1001] ...God anointed Solomon and gave him a gift. **God always has give gifts to lead His people.** Search the Scriptures. **Gifted human beings has led God's people,** and so he... Solomon prayed for a gift of wisdom, and God gave him the gift of wisdom to lead the people.

COLOSSIANS 4:5

5. *Walk in wisdom toward them that are without, redeeming the time.*

II CHRONICLES 9:22-23

22. *And king Solomon passed all the kings of the earth in riches and wisdom.*

23. *And all the kings of the earth sought the presence of Solomon, to hear his wisdom, that God had put in his heart.*

I KINGS 10:6-8

6. *And she said to the king, It was a true report that I heard in mine own land of thy acts and of thy wisdom.* 7. *Howbeit I believed not the words, until I came, and mine eyes had seen it: and, behold, the half was not told me: thy wisdom and prosperity exceedeth the fame which I heard.*

8. *Happy are thy men, happy are these thy servants, which stand continually before thee, and that hear thy wisdom.*

LUKE 11:31

31. *The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with the men of this generation, and condemn them: for she came from the utmost parts of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon is here.*

PROVERBS 1:1-3

1. *The proverbs of Solomon the son of David, king of Israel;*

2. *To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding;*

3. *To receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, and judgment, and equity;*

PROVERBS 3:13

13. *Happy is the man that findeth wisdom, and the man that getteth understanding.*

PROVERBS 8:10-11

10. *Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold.*

11. *For wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it.*

16. *How much better is it to get wisdom than gold! and to get understanding rather to be chosen than silver!*

PROVERBS 24:3

3. *Through wisdom is an house builded; and by understanding it is established:*

10. *The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do his commandments: his praise endureth for ever.*

THE MARK OF THE BEAST [54-0513] [NB note: reading from Revelation 17:9]

Now, I want to ask you something. **Is wisdom one of the gifts of the Holy Spirit?** Is that right? How many believes that the Bible, I Corinthians 12, teaches that the gifts and all--in the Church, is wisdom, let's see, one of the gifts? **Well, how could you say there's no speaking in tongues then? How do you say there's no interpretation of tongue? How could you say there's no Divine healing?** For the same body... If I'm a body, got a hand on this side, and hand on this side, and a foot there, how can you say that the hand's not the foot? Didn't you know what Paul said?

Now, watch, he's speaking in the last days, directly to the Body, said, "*Here's to the one that has wisdom.*" Oh, I like this. Oh, my. Here's the one that'll shock you. Listen to this. All right.

Here is the mind that has wisdom.

If those Holy Spirit gifts didn't come down to all the age, why did he speak this for the last days then? If there's going to be no gifts in the Church in the last days, why did he direct this to the last days then?
