# **A Sure Foundation Pt2**

### **ISAIAH 28:16**

16. Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious corner stone, <u>a sure foundation</u>: he that believeth shall not make haste.

### **MATTHEW 16:13-18**

- 13. When Jesus came into the coasts of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, saying, Whom do men say that I the Son of man am? 14. And they said, Some say that thou art John the Baptist: some, Elias; and others, Jeremias, or one of the prophets.
- 15. He saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am?
- 16. And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.
- 17. And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not <u>revealed</u> it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.
- 18. And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and <u>upon this rock I will build my</u> <u>church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it</u>.

### **MATTHEW 7:24-29**

- 24. Therefore whosoever <u>heareth</u> these sayings of mine, <u>and doeth them</u>, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock: 25. And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.
- 26. And every one that <u>heareth</u> these sayings of mine, <u>and doeth them not</u>, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand: 27. And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it.
- 28. And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his [doctrine]: 29. For he taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.

- 1) teaching, i.e. that which is taught; doctrine, teaching, concerning something
- 2) the act of teaching, instruction; in religious assemblies of the Christians, to speak in the way of teaching, in distinction from other modes of speaking in public

### **LUKE 6:47-48**

47. Whosoever cometh to me, and <u>heareth</u> my sayings, <u>and doeth</u> them, I will shew you to whom he is like: 48. He is like a man which built an house, and <u>digged deep</u>, and laid the [<u>foundation</u>] on a rock: and when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently upon that house, and could not shake it: for <u>it was founded upon a rock</u>.

1) laid down as a foundation, the foundation (of a building, wall, city), metaphorically, the foundations, beginnings, first principals, of institution or system of truth

### **LUKE 6:49**

49. But he that <u>heareth</u>, <u>and doeth not</u>, is like <u>a man</u> that <u>without a [foundation]</u> built an house upon the earth; against which the stream did beat vehemently, and immediately it fell; and the ruin of that house was great.

### **REVELATION 17:8**

8. The beast that thou sawest was, and is not; and shall ascend out of <u>the bottomless pit</u>, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.

WHY ARE WE NOT A DENOMINATION? [58-0927] What is it? The bottomless pit. **There's no foundation** for a Catholic doctrine. There's no Bible for Catholic doctrine. There's no such a thing as any Bible for any Catholic doctrine, not at all.

### THE MARK OF THE BEAST [54-0513]

Not on the Bible... Out of a bunch of superstitions it was made up. There's no background for it. Where do you get purgatory at? Where do you get this non-meat eating, the priest not marrying, and all these other things they do, confessions? Where do you get that at? There's no place nowhere to find it. It come out of hell.

## JAIRUS, A SECRET BELIEVER [55-0604]

Now, in order to have faith, faith has to have a basis. You just can't let faith be loose and wild. <u>Faith has to rest itself, not upon the shifting sands of man's reasoning. Faith is based on the solid Rock of God's Word</u>. Faith rests right on God's Word.

If the Lord has said so, then that settles it. It doesn't shift about. Men how sometimes they can explain anything so real and paint the picture so real, but yet <u>faith will never</u> <u>look at that if God's Word is contrary to it</u>. It'll track straight to God's Word.

FELLOWSHIP [56-0212] <u>Faith's not based upon sifting sands of man's theology.</u> <u>Faith's not based upon the document of some church or some creed. Faith is based solidly on the unmovable Word of God.</u>

JESUS CHRIST THE SAME... [55-0806] <u>Faith can only be based upon</u> the--<u>the solid</u> Rock of God's eternal Word. That's the only place that faith can rest.

### **EPHESIANS 4:11-15**

11. And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; 12. For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: 13. Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: 14. That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; 15. But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:

### I TIMOTHY 4:6

6. <u>If thou put the brethren in remembrance of these things, thou shalt be a good minister of Jesus Christ</u>, nourished up in the words of faith and of <u>good doctrine</u>, whereunto thou hast attained.

### **ISAIAH 29:24**

24. They also that erred in spirit shall come to understanding, and they that murmured shall learn doctrine.

### **ROMANS 10:13-17**

- 13. For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.
- 14. How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?
- 15. <u>And how shall they preach, except they be sent</u>? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!
- 16. But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Esaias saith, Lord, who hath believed our report? 17. So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

### **HEBREWS 12:25-29**

- 25. See that ye refuse not him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more shall not we escape, if we turn away from him that speaketh from heaven:
- 26. Whose voice then shook the earth: but now he hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven.
- 27. And this word, Yet once more, signifieth <u>the removing of those things that are shaken</u>, as of things that are made, **that those things which cannot be shaken may remain**.
- 28. Wherefore we receiving <u>a kingdom which cannot be moved</u>, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear: 29. For our God is a consuming fire.
