A Sure Foundation Pt3

HEBREWS 1:1-2

1. God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, 2. <u>Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son</u>, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;

DEUTERONOMY 4:2

<u>Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought</u> <u>from it</u>, that ye may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you.

PROVERBS 30:5-6

5. *Every word of God is pure*: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him.

6. <u>Add thou not unto his words</u>, lest he reprove thee, and thou be found a liar.

REVELATION 22:18-19

18. For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, <u>If any man shall add unto these things</u>, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book:
19. <u>And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy</u>, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

BRASS SERPENT [53-1121]

I want to get this on God's Word, for after all, <u>this is the only foundation that anyone</u> <u>can build on, correctly. God will never recognize any foundation but this Word</u>. "For no other foundation can be laid than that which is already laid." Is that...? And this is God's Word in the beginning, if anything else is said, <u>if it doesn't compare with this Word</u>, <u>then it isn't of God</u>, I wouldn't think; 'cause the Bible said, "He that takes away, or adds to: the same shall be taken out of, his part, out of the Book of Life." <u>So, we want to be sure that</u> we keep our doctrine always on THUS SAITH THE LORD.

GENESIS 3:4 And the serpent said unto the woman, <u>Ye shall not surely die</u>:

ROMANS 3:3-5

3. For what if some did not believe? shall their unbelief make the faith of God without effect?

4. God forbid: yea, *let God be true, but every man a liar*; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged.

5. But if our unrighteousness commend the righteousness of God, what shall we say? Is God unrighteous who taketh vengeance? (*I speak as a man*)

I CORINTHIANS 7:12a

12a. But to the rest speak I, not the Lord:

I CORINTHIANS 7:25

25. Now concerning virgins <u>I have no commandment of the Lord: yet I give my</u> <u>judgment</u>, as one that hath obtained mercy of the Lord to be faithful.

II CORINTHIANS 11:17

17. *That which I speak, I speak it not after the Lord*, but as it were foolishly, in this confidence of boasting.

II PETER 3:15-17

15. And account that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you; 16. As also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest, as they do also <u>the other scriptures</u>, unto their own destruction. 17. Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, <u>beware lest ye</u> <u>also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own stedfastness</u>.

II TIMOTHY 3:16

16. <u>All scripture is given by inspiration of God</u>, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

<u>I TIMOTHY 1:3-4</u>

3. As I besought thee to abide still at Ephesus, when I went into Macedonia, that thou mightest charge some <u>that they teach no other doctrine</u>, 4. Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: so do.

<u>II TIMOTHY 2:15-19a</u>

15. Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. 16. But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness. 17. <u>And their word will eat as doth a canker</u>: of whom is Hymenaeus and Philetus; 18. Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the faith of some. 19a. <u>Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure</u>, having this seal, <u>The Lord knoweth them that are his</u>.

<u>II JOHN 1:7-11</u>

7. For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist. 8. Look to yourselves, that we lose not those things which we have wrought, but that we receive a full reward.

9. <u>Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God</u>. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son. 10. <u>If there</u> <u>come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into your house, neither</u> <u>bid him God speed</u>: 11. For he that biddeth him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds.

<u>I TIMOTHY 6:3-5</u>

3. <u>If any man teach otherwise</u>, and consent not to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness;

4. <u>He is proud, knowing nothing</u>, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings, 5. Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: <u>from such withdraw thyself</u>.

II CORINTHIANS 11:2-4

2. For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ.

3. But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ. 4. <u>For if he that cometh preacheth</u> <u>another Jesus, whom we have not preached</u>, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, <u>or another gospel</u>, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.

GALATIANS 1:6-12

6. I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel: 7. Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ. 8. But <u>though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel</u> <u>unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed</u>. 9. As we said before, so say I now again, <u>If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye</u> <u>have received, let him be accursed</u>. 10. For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ. 11. But I certify you, brethren, that <u>the gospel which was preached of me is not after man</u>. 12. For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, <u>but by the revelation of Jesus Christ</u>.

ROMANS 2:16

16. In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ *according to my gospel*.

<u>I JOHN 4:6</u>

6. We are of God: <u>he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us.</u> <u>Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error</u>.

I CORINTHIANS 14:36-38

36. What? came the word of God out from you? or came it unto you only?

37. If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the

things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord.

38. But if any man be ignorant, let him be ignorant.
