I CORINTHIANS 12:4-10a

4. Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. 5. And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. 6. And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all. 7. But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. 8. For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; 9. To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; 10a. To another the working of miracles;

EXODUS 7:8-9

And the man believed the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way. 51. And as he was now going down, his servants met him, and told him, saying, Thy son liveth. 52. Then enquired he of them the hour when he began to amend. And they said unto him, Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him. 53. So the father knew that it was at the same hour, in the which Jesus said unto him, Thy son liveth: and himself believed, and his whole house. 54. This is again the second miracle that Jesus did, when he was come out of Judaea into Galilee.

JOHN 12:37

37. But though he had done so many miracles before them, yet they believed not on him:

LUKE 16: 31

31. And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.

ACTS 19:11-12

- 11. And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul:
- 12. So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

HEBREWS 11:32/39-40

- <u>39</u>. And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise:
- 40. God having provided some better thing for us, that <u>they without us should not be made</u> perfect.
