What Are You Yielding To?

MARK 5:15

15. And they come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the devil, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

JESUS CHRIST THE SAME YESTERDAY TODAY AND FOREVER [55-0116E]

That boy was so completely surrendered to Satan till the devil used his tongue. You believe the devil can use your tongue? Certainly he does: Make you say things that you don't want to say, make you lie, steal, make you tell things that's not right, say bad words that God don't want you to say. The devil gets complete control of you. Well, then if he gets all the way control of you, you don't know what you're going to say. You become a mad man. And a person... Do you believe your tongue can be used for Jesus Christ? Certainly it can.

AND THEN JESUS CAME [57-0302]

Now, when the devil possesses a person, he becomes many times his strength. And if the devil can give you twice your strength, what do you think God could do to you people setting there in a wheelchair? What do you think God could do to you that's a sinner? If the devil can drive you into a barroom, or out in the street immorally, or doing the things of the world, which is **contrary to your own nature. 'Cause you were born to be a son and daughter of God**, and the devil can make you do things and cheat on your husband, cheat on your wife, steal, lie; **how much more can God do when He gets full possession of you**?

ROMANS 6:12-18

- 12. Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof.
- 13. Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but <u>yield</u> <u>yourselves unto God</u>, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God.
- 14. For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.

- 15. What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid.
- 16. Know ye not, that <u>to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are</u> <u>to whom ye obey</u>; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?
- 17. But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.
- 18. Being then <u>made free from sin</u>, ye became the servants of righteousness.

- 36. They also which saw it told them by what means he that was possessed of the devils was healed. 37. Then the whole multitude of the country of the Gadarenes round about besought him to depart from them; for they were taken with great fear: and he went up into the ship, and returned back again. 38. Now the man out of whom the devils were departed besought him that he might be with him: but Jesus sent him away, saying,

Dekapolis {dek-ap'-ol-is}

1) Decapolis meaning "ten cities", a track of land so called from the ten cities that were in it; which according to Pliny, were the following; Damascus, Opoton, Philadelphia, Raphana, Scythopolis, Gadara, Hippondion, Pella, Galasa, and Canatha. (Gill)
