Prophets

EPHESIANS 4:11

11. *And he gave some, apostles; and some, **prophets**; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;*

GENESIS 20:7

7. *Now therefore restore the man his wife; for **he is a prophet**, and he shall pray for thee, and thou shalt live: and if thou restore her not, know thou that thou shalt surely die, thou, and all that are thine.*

THE UNCONDITIONAL COVENANT [54-0306] So if you do what God tells you not to do, you're backslid. So Abraham was setting out there **backslid and telling a lie**. But God couldn't turn His child down. He give him the promise, unconditionally.

I SAMUEL 9:9

9. *(Beforetime in Israel, when a man went to enquire of God, thus he spake, Come, and let us go to the **seer**: for he that is now called a **Prophet** was beforetime called a **Seer**.)*

JEREMIAH 1:5

5. *Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I **ordained thee a prophet** unto the nations.*

EXODUS 20:18-19

18. *And all the people saw the thunderings, and the lightnings, and the noise of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking: and when the people saw it, they removed, and stood afar off.*

19. *And they said unto Moses, Speak thou with us, and we will hear: but **let not God speak with us, lest we die**.*

DEUTERONOMY 18:20-22

20. *But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in my name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other gods, even that prophet shall die.* 21. *And if thou say in thine heart, **How shall we know the word which the LORD hath not spoken?*** 22. *When a prophet speaketh in the name of the LORD, **if the thing follow not, nor come to pass,** that is the thing which the LORD hath not spoken, but the prophet hath spoken it presumptuously: thou shalt not be afraid of him.*

EXODUS 28:4-5

4. *And these are the garments which they shall make; a breastplate, and an ephod, and a robe, and a broidered coat, a mitre, and a girdle: and they shall make holy garments for Aaron thy brother, and his sons, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.*
5. *And they shall take gold, and blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine linen.*

EXODUS 28:15

15. *And thou shalt make **the breastplate of judgment** with cunning work; after the work of the ephod thou shalt make it; of gold, of blue, and of purple, and of scarlet, and of fine twined linen, shalt thou make it.*

EXODUS 28:21

21. *And the stones shall be with the names of the children of Israel, twelve, according to their names, like the engravings of a signet; every one with his name shall they be according to the twelve tribes.*

EXODUS 28:29-30

29. *And Aaron shall bear the names of the children of Israel in the breastplate of judgment upon his heart, when he goeth in unto the holy place, for a memorial before the LORD continually.*
30. *And thou shalt **put in the [breastplate] of judgment the [Urim] and the [Thummim]**; and they shall be upon Aaron's heart, when he goeth in before the LORD: and Aaron shall bear the judgment of the children of Israel upon his heart before the LORD continually.*

HEBREW LEXICON - STRONG'S NUMBER 2833

Choshen {kho'-shen}

1) breastplate, breastpiece

1a) sacred pouch of the high priest designed to hold the Urim and Thummim

HEBREW LEXICON - STRONG'S NUMBER 224

'Uwriym {oo-reem'}

Urim = "lights?"

1) stones kept in a pouch on the high-priest's breastplate, used in determining God's decision in certain questions and issues

HEBREW LEXICON - STRONG'S NUMBER 8550

Tummiym {toom-meem'}

Thummim = "perfection"

1) stones provided for the means of achieving a sacred lot

1a) used with the Urim, the will of God was revealed

THE DOOR TO THE HEART [58-0112E]

In the Old Testament they had a way of testing whether a prophet was true or not. It was on the Urim-Thummim. And you Bible readers know what that was. It was a supernatural Light that went over the breastplate of Aaron, that reflected different colors. And if the dreamer or the prophet spoke, and **no matter how real it sound, if the Urim and the Thummim did not reflect that supernatural, it wasn't so.**

And in that priesthood the Urim-Thummim was taken away. But in this priesthood of the Lord we got another Urim-Thummim. That's His Word. **If it doesn't reflect on the Word, I'm just a little bit skeptic of it.**

THE BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT [58-0928M]

Now, you can take a little piece of Scripture here, say, "*Jesus did so-and-so and we ought to do the same.*" **You can make It say anything you want to make It say, but it's got to come all the way through and line up perfectly with the Word of God. Then it's right. That's God saying so. This is His Urim Thummim.**

THE QUEEN OF SHEBA [61-0219]

This is the Urim Thummim. Joseph Smith met an angel; it wasn't Scriptural. Now, if any angel or anything that's contrary to God's Word, **This is the full revelation of Jesus Christ. So therefore stay with It.**
