EPHESIANS 2:8-9

8. For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

9. Not of works, lest any man should boast.

10. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

HEAR YE HIM [56-0930]

That's the way man try to do today, is to merit their salvation. And there's not one thing you can do about it. <u>It's all amazing grace</u>. Oh, I love it. Nothing you can... Not by works, but by grace are you saved, that <u>unmerited grace</u>. God through the righteousness of the Lord Jesus Christ has saved you, and called you by His own grace.

SIR, WE WOULD SEE JESUS [60-0708]

We are absolutely unworthy of any blessing. There's nothing that we could do to merit that. But by **unmerited grace**, God gave us this privilege to be called His children, His sons and His daughters, sanctifying us as we confess our sin, sanctifying the world from us, that He might work His way through us by the Holy Spirit to do and will His work.

REDEMPTION IN COMPLETENESS IN JOY [54-0330]

Now, to every believer, born-again child of God, when death comes stealing to the door prematurely, <u>the Angel of God stands between you and the sickness</u>. Now, if you want to run right on to it, that's your business; but you don't have to. See? <u>He's standing between you and death</u>.

Twenty-three years ago in the Jewish Hospital, Dr. Morris Fletcher give me three hours; one of your best surgeons here in the city, give me three hours to live. I'm living tonight. Hallelujah. Why? By **unmerited grace**, the Angel of God stood between me and death to protect me, and I accepted It.
