### *Evangelists*

#### **EPHESIANS 4:11-12**

11. *And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; 12. For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:*

#### JESUS CHRIST THE SAME YESTERDAY TODAY AND FOREVER [62-0718]

Now, those gifts are for the perfecting of the church, to keep the church in order-- pastors, and teachers, and evangelists, and prophets, and so forth. Now, it's gifts.

Now, no matter how much these men here are gifted to preach, you've got to also believe what they preach, or it isn't going to do one good. Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that he might know your estate, and comfort your hearts; 9. With Onesimus, a faithful and beloved brother, who is one of you. They shall make known unto you all things which are done here. 10. Aristarchus my fellowprisoner saluteth you, and Marcus, sister's son to Barnabas, (touching whom ye received commandments: if he come unto you, receive him;) 11.
