JOB 1:6-12

- 6. Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them.
- 7. And the LORD said unto Satan, Whence comest thou? Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it.
- 8. And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil?
- 9. Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, Doth Job fear God for nought?
- 10. Hast not thou made an hedge about him, and about his house, and about all that he hath on every side? thou hast blessed the work of his hands, and his substance is increased in the land.
- 11. But put forth thine hand now, and touch all that he hath, and he will curse thee to thy face.
- 12. And the LORD said unto Satan, Behold, all that he hath is in thy power; only upon himself put not forth thine hand. So Satan went forth from the presence of the LORD.

GENESIS 3:1-5

- 1. Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?
- 2. And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden:
- 3. But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die.
- 4. And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die:
- 5. For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil.

ISAIAH 14:12-15

- 13. For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north:
- 14. I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.
- 15. Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.

ACTS 16:16-18

- 16. And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying:
- 17. The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation.

LUKE 4:1-13

- 1. And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,

- 3. And the devil said unto him, <u>If thou be the Son of God</u>, command this stone that it be made bread.

- 5. And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time.

- 7. *If* thou therefore wilt worship me, all shall be thine.

- 11. And in their hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone.

- 13. And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season.
