God is going to dwell among His people. That's what He wants to do now. <u>We can</u> <u>receive the Message, as saying</u>... If I was a young man and--and hunting for a wife, and I could find a wife, I said, "She's just perfect. She's a Christian. She's a lady. She's all this, I got confidence." No matter how much confidence, how much I think she's nice, I've got to receive her, she's got to receive me; see, upon these vows.
