# HEBREWS CHAPTER 4 [57-0901E]

Is it becoming a member of the greatest church in the city? Wearing better clothes? Is it education? Is it money, so we can quit work and just lay down, rest the rest of our life, as we call it? <u>That's not it</u>.

# HEBREWS 4:2-11

For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but <u>the word preached did not</u> profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it.
For we which have <u>believed do enter into [rest]</u>, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my [rest]: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.

4. For he spake in a certain place of the seventh day on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works. 5. And in this place again, If they shall enter into my [rest].

6. Seeing therefore it remaineth that some must enter therein, and <u>they to whom it was first</u> *preached entered not in because of unbelief*:

7. Again, he limiteth a certain day, saying in David, To day, after so long a time; as it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts.

8. For if Jesus had given them rest, then would he not afterward have spoken of another day.

9. <u>There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God</u>. 10. For he that is entered into his [rest], he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from his. 11. <u>Let us labour</u> <u>therefore to enter into that [rest]</u>, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.

# THE INTER VEIL [56-0121]

Now, that is what I find around most Christian lives. Most, I hate to say it that way, but it's true. The most people that can profess Christianity, they seem to have such a hard struggling time to hold on. I believe it's because of a lack of correct teaching of--of the Bible. <u>There's no such a thing as holding on. He done the holding on</u>.

The whole Christian principle is based upon rest. "Come unto Me all ye that labor and heavy laden. I will give you rest." Don't have to worry and struggle. You're just resting; that's all. <u>Given rest, you enter in peace, that the whole thing's finished</u>. "Them who He has called, He has justified. Those who He has justified, He has already glorified," Scripture quoting. Notice. <u>It's nothing that you do, or what you can do. It's what God has done for you in Christ</u>.

Don't be disturbed. Let God...
