

Return, Revive, And Grow

HOSEA 14:7

7. *They that dwell under his shadow shall return; they shall revive as the corn, and grow as the vine: the scent thereof shall be as the wine of Lebanon.*

RETURN:

ISAIAH 44:22

22. *I have blotted out, as a thick cloud, thy transgressions, and, as a cloud, thy sins: return unto me; for I have redeemed thee.*

MALACHI 3:7b

7b. *Return unto me, and I will return unto you, saith the LORD of hosts.*

JAMES 4:7-8

7. *Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.*
8. *Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.*

DEUTERONOMY 4:29

PSALM 85:6

6. *Wilt thou not revive us again: that thy people may rejoice in thee?*

PSALM 138:7

7. *Though I walk in the midst of trouble, thou wilt revive me: thou shalt stretch forth thine hand against the wrath of mine enemies, and thy right hand shall save me.*

ISAIAH 57:15

15. *For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the [contrite] ones.*
