LUKE 2:7

7. And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him <u>in a manger</u>; because there was no room for them in the inn.

THE SMYRNAEAN CHURCH AGE [60-1206] ...it ought to be striking! Jehovah! Jehovah, over a pile of manure in a barn, crying. **Jehovah, in a manger** of straw.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS [59-1223] And we were riding last night showing the kiddies all the houses decorated and everything, which is awful nice. But I thought, if I ever had on--anything on my house that I ever wanted to write, would be a neon sign: "Trusting Christ Will Be In Your Christmas." That's right. Put Christ back into Christmas.

LUKE 2:8-20

- 8. And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night.
- 9. And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid.
- 10. And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be **to all people**.

- 17. And when they had seen it, <u>they made known abroad</u> the saying which was told them concerning this child.
- 18. <u>And all they that heard it wondered at those things</u> which were told them by the shepherds.
- 19. But Mary kept all these things, and pondered them in her heart.
- 20. And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told unto them.

MATTHEW 2:1-6

- 1. Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem,
- 2. Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him.
- 3. When Herod the king had heard these things, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him.
- 4. And when he had gathered <u>all the chief priests and scribes</u> of the people together, he demanded of them where Christ should be born.
- 5. And they said unto him, In Bethlehem of Judaea: for thus it is written by the prophet,
- 6. And thou Bethlehem, in the land of Juda, art not the least among the princes of Juda: for out of thee shall come a Governor, that shall rule my people Israel.

WHY IT HAD TO BE SHEPHERD [64-1221]

So it disturbed the Sanhedrin, and they called for the Scribes to come read. And they read Micah's story, the prophet which said, "Thou Bethlehem, art thou not the least of all the princes of Judah (the least), but out of thee shall come a governor that shall rule My people, Israel." And after the Scriptures being read (and still being vindicated before their eyes), they still didn't accept It, though the Scripture said so.

A TESTIMONY UPON THE SEA [62-0726]

Think of Jehovah God in a manger crying like a baby. Think of Him playing as a boy. Think of Him building a house out of the very timber that He created.
