MATTHEW 16:16-18

16. And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.
17. And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.

18. And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and <u>upon this rock I will build my</u> <u>church</u>; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

WHY SOME PEOPLE CAN'T KEEP THE VICTORY [57-0324]

After while little Adam said, "It's not time to turn a television on, but darling, the sun's going down. <u>It's time for us to go worship</u>." Oh, God. "<u>It's time for us to go</u> <u>worship</u>." Not, "We're going down to hear Dr. Jones, and we're going down to hear Bill Branham or anybody else." But, "We're going up to worship."

HEAR YE HIM [57-0725]

Adam says to Eve, "Sweetheart, <u>let's go up to church</u>. It's time to worship Father." They didn't have plush seats. They had no denominations. They went right up into the great cathedral, and there, when that great Light come down, and they worshipped God.

REMEMBERING THE LORD [62-1209]

I like the evening service, when the sun goes down, something, another. It was God in the garden of Eden, to Adam, would come up in the cool of the evening and talk to Adam. See, and I like the evening service.

GENESIS 3:8

THE JUNCTION TIME [56-0122]

Notice this. When Cain and Abel, both of them, both of them boys built an altar to God. <u>They built a church to the Lord</u>.

THE SPOKEN WORD IS THE ORIGINAL SEED [62-0318]

<u>They both went to church</u>. They both paid their dues. They both obligated. They got down and worshiped the same God. And one was received, and the other one lost. How's it come? Jesus said, *"Upon this rock I'll build My Church."*

DOCTOR MOSES [55-0114]

<u>Cain built him a church, an altar</u>. Cain worshipped at the altar. Cain made a sacrifice. He was just as religious as Abel was. But Cain brought works, fruit of the field, and laid them on the altar.

DOCTOR MOSES [55-0114]

But Abel, by spiritual revelation, revealed to him by God through his faith, that it was not fruit. It was a blood that caused it. So by a spiritual revelation, at <u>the first church</u> <u>buildings that was ever made</u>, the first altar directed, there was the pro and con.
