## I CORINTHIANS 6:12

12. *All things are lawful unto me, but all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any.*

## GALATIANS 5:1

1. *Stand fast therefore in the [liberty] wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.*

## GALATIANS 2:18

18. *For if I build again the things which I destroyed, I make myself a transgressor.*

## GALATIANS 5:13

13. *For, brethren, ye have been called unto [liberty]; only use not [liberty] for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.*

## I PETER 2:16

16. *As free, and not using your [liberty] for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God.*

## II PETER 2:19-22

19. *While they promise them [liberty], they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage.*

20. For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, **and overcome**, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning.

21. For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them.

22. But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire.

### **JAMES 1:22-25**

22. But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

23. For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass:

24. For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.

25. But whoso looketh into **the perfect law of [liberty]**, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.
