

# The Definition Of The Word Church Pt5

*From Shiloh To Gibeon*

## JOSHUA 18:1

1. And the whole congregation of the children of Israel assembled together at Shiloh, and set up the tabernacle of the congregation there. And the land was subdued before them.

## I SAMUEL 1:3

3. And this man went up out of his city yearly to worship and to sacrifice unto the LORD of hosts in Shiloh. And the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, the priests of the LORD, were there.

## I SAMUEL 3:21

21. And the LORD appeared again in Shiloh: for the LORD revealed himself to Samuel in Shiloh by the word of the LORD.

## JEREMIAH 7:12

12. But go ye now unto my place which was in Shiloh, where I set my name at the first, and see what I did to it for the wickedness of my people Israel.

## JEREMIAH 7:14

14. Therefore will I do unto this house, which is called by my name, wherein ye trust, and unto the place which I gave to you and to your fathers, as I have done to Shiloh.

## JEREMIAH 26:6

6. Then will I make this house like Shiloh, and will make this city a curse to all the nations of the earth.

## I CHRONICLES 21:29

29. For the tabernacle of the LORD, which Moses made in the wilderness, and the altar of the burnt offering, were at that season in the high place at Gibeon.

Gib'own {ghib-ohn'}

Gibeon = "hill city"

1) a Levitical city of Benjamin, modern 'el-Jib', which lies 5 miles from Jerusalem

### **JOSHUA 10:10-14**

10. And the LORD discomfited them before Israel, and slew them with a great slaughter at Gibeon, and chased them along the way that goeth up to Bethhoron, and smote them to Azekah, and unto Makkedah. 11. And it came to pass, as they fled from before Israel, and were in the going down to Bethhoron, that the LORD cast down great stones from heaven upon them unto Azekah, and they died: **they were more which died with hailstones than they whom the children of Israel slew with the sword.** 12. Then spake Joshua to the LORD in the day when the LORD delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel, **Sun, stand thou still upon Gibeon;** and thou, Moon, in the valley of Ajalon. 13. And the sun stood still, and the moon stayed, until the people had avenged themselves upon their enemies. Is not this written in the book of Jasher? So the sun stood still in the midst of heaven, and hasted not to go down about a whole day. 14. And there was no day like that before it or after it, that the LORD hearkened unto the voice of a man: for the LORD fought for Israel.

### **JOSHUA 11:19**

19. There was not a city that made peace with the children of Israel, save the Hivites the inhabitants of Gibeon: **all other they took in battle.**

### **II CHRONICLES 1:3-7**

3. So Solomon, and all the congregation with him, went to **the high place that was at [Gibeon]; for there was the tabernacle of the congregation of God,** which Moses the servant of the LORD had made in the wilderness. 4. But the ark of God had David brought up from Kirjathjearim to the place which David had prepared for it: for he had pitched a tent for it at Jerusalem. 5. Moreover the brasen altar, that Bezaleel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, had made, he put before the tabernacle of the LORD: and Solomon and the congregation sought unto it. 6. And Solomon went up thither to **the brasen altar** before the LORD, which was at **the tabernacle of the congregation,** and offered a thousand burnt offerings upon it. 7. In that night did God appear unto Solomon, and said unto him, **Ask what I shall give thee.**

### **II CHRONICLES 1:13**

13. Then Solomon came from his journey to **the high place that was at Gibeon** to Jerusalem, from before **the tabernacle of the congregation,** and reigned over Israel.

### **PSALM 122:1**

1. I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD.

### **PSALM 22:22**

22. I will declare thy name unto my brethren: in the midst of the congregation will I praise thee.

**PSALM 22:25**

25. *My praise shall be of thee in the great congregation: I will pay my vows before them that fear him.*

**PSALM 35:18**

18. *I will give thee thanks in the great congregation: I will praise thee among much people.*

**PSALM 40:9-10**

9. *I have preached righteousness in the great congregation: lo, I have not refrained my lips, O LORD, thou knowest.*

10. *I have not hid thy righteousness within my heart; I have declared thy faithfulness and thy salvation: I have not concealed thy lovingkindness and thy truth from the great congregation.*

**PSALM 63:1-2** [A Psalm of David, when he was in the wilderness of Judah.]

1. *O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is;*
2. *To see thy power and thy glory, so as I have seen thee in the sanctuary.*

**PSALM 107:31-32**

31. *Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!* 32. *Let them exalt him also in the congregation of the people, and praise him in the assembly of the elders.*

**ACTS 13:22b**

*...he raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, **a man after mine own heart**, which shall fulfil all my will.*

THE SEAL OF THE CHRIST [55-0312]

of them. They tell me, the ministers, that the church pews are empty, emptying out, because that people are beginning to go... The world offers so much class, and so much fancy, and--and tinsel upon the things of the world, and the people fall for that.

**Now, that shows that at the beginning, they had nothing to start with. For if you love God, I--you can't--you couldn't wire you away from church. They couldn't chain you away from it. They can't hide a believer from God.** He... In his heart, oh, he might be all deceived. Now, there's many people that actually think that they're right. But if they'd just stop and watch your life, you'd see they're--the Spirit of God isn't in there. **If it doesn't cope with this Bible, then there's something wrong with the experience that you have.** So you must come back and line up with the Word to see if the Life of God is in you. If you love the world better than you love prayer meeting, if you'd rather watch a television program than to pray, **there's something wrong with you.** If you'd rather take a Sunday afternoon ride instead of going to church, **there's something wrong with you somewhere.**

1. *Praise ye the LORD. I will praise the LORD with my whole heart, in the assembly of the upright, and in the congregation.*

#### **PSALM 47:1** [To the chief Musician, A Psalm for the sons of Korah.]

1. *O clap your hands, all ye people; shout unto God with the voice of triumph.*

#### **PSALM 134:1** [A Song of degrees.]

1. *Behold, bless ye the LORD, all ye servants of the LORD, which by night stand in the house of the LORD.*
2. *Lift up your hands in the sanctuary, and bless the LORD.*

#### **PSALM 149:1**

1. *Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a new song, and his praise in the congregation of saints.*

#### **PSALM 150:1-6**

1. *Praise ye the LORD. Praise God in his sanctuary: praise him in the firmament of his power.*
2. *Praise him for his mighty acts: praise him according to his excellent greatness.*
3. *Praise him with the sound of the trumpet: praise him with the psaltery and harp.*
4. *Praise him with the timbrel and dance: praise him with stringed instruments and organs.*
5. *Praise him upon the loud cymbals: praise him upon the high sounding cymbals.*
6. *Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD.*
