## ACTS 22:19

19. And I said, Lord, they know that I imprisoned and beat *in every [synagogue]* them that believed on thee:

# ACTS 26:11

11. And I punished them oft *in every [synagogue]*, and compelled them to blaspheme; and being exceedingly mad against them, I persecuted them even unto strange cities.

# ACTS 9:19-20

19. And when he had received meat, he was strengthened. Then was Saul certain days with the disciples which were at Damascus.

20. And straightway he preached Christ *in the [synagogues]*, that he is the Son of God.

# ACTS 13:5

5. And when they were at Salamis, they preached the word of God <u>in the [synagogues]</u> of the Jews: and they had also John to their minister.

# ACTS 13:14-16

14. But when they departed from Perga, they came to Antioch in Pisidia, and went <u>into the</u> [synagogue] on the sabbath day, and sat down. 15. And after the reading of the law and the prophets the rulers of the synagogue sent unto them, saying, Ye men and brethren, if ye have any word of exhortation for the people, say on. 16. Then Paul stood up, and beckoning with his hand said, Men of Israel, and ye that fear God, give audience.

# ACTS 14:1

1. And it came to pass in Iconium, that they went both together <u>into the [synagogue]</u> of the Jews, and so spake, that a great multitude both of the Jews and also of the Greeks believed.

## ACTS 17:10-13

10. And the brethren immediately sent away Paul and Silas by night unto Berea: who coming thither went *into the synagogue* of the Jews.

11. These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.

## ACTS 17:16-17

16. Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was stirred in him, when he saw the city wholly given to idolatry. 17. Therefore disputed he <u>in the [synagogue]</u> with the Jews, and with the devout persons, and in the market daily with them that met with him.

# ACTS 18:4

4. And he reasoned *in the [synagogue]* every sabbath, and persuaded the Jews and the Greeks.

## ACTS 18:19

19. And he came to Ephesus, and left them there: but he himself entered <u>into the [synagogue]</u>, and reasoned with the Jews.

# ACTS 19:8

8. And he went *into the [synagogue]*, and spake boldly for the space of three months, disputing and persuading the things concerning the kingdom of God.

# **MATTHEW 18:20**

20. For where two or three are **[gathered together]** in my name, there am I in the midst of them.

#### ACTS 11:26

26. And when he had found him, he brought him unto Antioch. And it came to pass, that a whole year they [assembled] themselves with the church, and taught much people. And the disciples were called Christians first in Antioch.

### ACTS 14:27-28

27. And when they were come, and had [gathered] the church [together], they rehearsed all that God had done with them, and how he had opened the door of faith unto the Gentiles.
28. And there they abode long time with the disciples.

## ACTS 15:30

30. So when they were dismissed, they came to Antioch: and when they had [*gathered*] the multitude [*together*], they delivered the epistle:

## ACTS 20:7-8

And upon the first day of the week, when the disciples [came together] to break bread, Paul preached unto them, ready to depart on the morrow; and continued his speech until midnight.
 And there were many lights in the upper chamber, where they were [gathered together].

## ACTS 1:4

4. And, being [assembled together] with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me.
