Moses Pt2

GENESIS 15:13-14

13. *And he said unto Abram, Know of a surety that thy seed shall be a stranger in a land that is not theirs, and shall serve them; and they shall afflict them **four hundred years**;*

14. *And also that nation, whom they shall serve, will I judge: and afterward shall they come out with great substance.*

EXODUS 1:8

8. *Now there arose up a new king over Egypt, which knew not Joseph.*

EXODUS 2:21-22

21. *And Moses was content to dwell with the man: and he gave Moses Zipporah his daughter.*

22. *And she bare him a son, and he called his name Gershom: for he said, I have been a stranger in a strange land.*

A PERSONAL EXPERIENCE WITH GOD [54-0724]

...trying to do it within himself forty years before that, become a failure and had lost all the vision of victory and of freedom for the people enslaved.

THE UNCHANGEABLE GOD, WORKING IN AN UNEXPECTABLE WAY [62-0120]

Now, the strange thing is, with a call of God on his life, I'd imagine Moses was never able to get away from that; never able.

And there may be people here tonight listening right to us, that down through your life, somewhere, you felt there was a call in your life, and you've just never heeded to it.

You'll be miserable as long as you live, till you heed to that life.

EXODUS 2:23-25

23. *And it came to pass in process of time, that the king of Egypt died: and the children of Israel sighed by reason of the bondage, and they cried, and their cry came up unto God by reason of the bondage.*

24. *And God heard their groaning, and **God remembered his covenant** with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob.*

25. *And God looked upon the children of Israel, and God had respect unto them.*

THE BELIEVER'S POSITION IN CHRIST [55-0116A]

...**Moses had forgot** about freedom, God's promise that he would free them, **but God hadn't forgot His promise.**

AS I WAS WITH MOSES [60-0911M]

But we find here that God **in spite of all the failure** that Moses had done, **He still had His hand on him.**

EXODUS 3:1-2

1. *Now Moses kept the flock of Jethro his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, even to Horeb.*

2. *And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed.*

EXODUS 3:7-8a

7. *And the LORD said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows;*

8a. *And **I am come down to deliver them** out of the hand of the Egyptians,*

EXODUS 3:10

10. *Come now therefore, and **I will send thee** unto Pharaoh, that thou mayest bring forth my people the children of Israel out of Egypt.*

THE ARROW OF GOD'S DELIVERANCE [56-0801]

Why, the reason Moses failed in the first place... Here's what was the matter. **It was the lack of having what the burning bush had.** That's right. And what's our failure today, is lack having what the Holy Spirit has. And the Holy Spirit has all good things for us. And if we receive the Holy Spirit, then all things are possible; and **not only possible, but promised to us.**

AN EXODUS [56-0615]

And in five minutes time, surrendered in the Presence of the Fire of God, he was better equipped than all the equipment in the world could make him.

AS I WAS WITH MOSES [60-0911M]

I don't have much confidence in anybody that's too afraid to do anything. I'd rather be found a failure than too lazy to try.

WHAT IS THAT IN YOUR HAND? [55-1120]

...God told him, said, *"I've seen the affliction of My people. I've heard their groans and moans, and I'm come down to deliver them. And I want you (the one that made a failure forty years ago), I want you to go right back and backtrack yourself."*

HEBREWS 11:24-27

24. *By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;*

25. *Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;*

26. *Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompence of the reward.*

27. *By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.*
