ACTS 2:1

1. *And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.*

HEBREWS 10:24-25

24. *And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:*

25. *Not forsaking the **assembling** of ourselves **together**, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.*

ABRAHAM [56-1208]

Church is a gathering place where we come in one common grounds and worship God.

HEAR YE HIM [60-0712] ...a church is where the people have gathered at.

BE NOT AFRAID, IT IS I [61-0414]

The church is a house of God where Christ lives and manifests Himself amongst the people.

ORDINATION [62-1104E]

A church is a group of people that's gathered together, without organization.

THE ONCOMING STORM [60-0229]

...the church is where judgment ought to be preached in the power of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus and a warning.

AT THY WORD [51-0928]

...we cannot accommodate the people in churches, that comes to the meetings, for seating room and so forth. But my favorite place to have services is in the church. The church is a place where the Angels of God encamped around.

ACTS 11:25-26

25. Then departed Barnabas to Tarsus, for to seek Saul:

THE DEEP CALLING TO THE DEEP [56-0415]

When the doctor's done all he can do, then I come to try to try to help you to get to God (See?); not to take you away from your doctor, **not to take you away from your church, but to help bring you to Christ** (See?), so you can believe.

THIRSTING FOR LIFE [59-0414]

I send people back to their home church.

...when we leave, we don't want you to just quit coming to church now; we want you to just keep on coming; just keep right on coming anyhow. If I lived around here, I--maybe this would probably this be my church home right here, if I lived here, be right here. I like it; it's a wonderful little church; got a lovely little pastor here. And--and I'm sure that any man that preaches the Full Gospel, I'd be represented there, because that's what I believe.

JESUS CHRIST THE SAME YESTERDAY TODAY AND FOREVER [58-0223]

If we can get the ministers to cooperate, so that the--the man when he's converted, he can have a church home to go to... If you turn him back out in the--the devil's pig pen, then he'll become back again just like he was. But if you got a place that you can direct him to, some good... Like Jesus with the Samaritan, he taken him to the inn. He said the Good Samaritan taking the m--the falling man to the inn. That's... **We got to have a place like that.**

JAIRUS AND DIVINE HEALING [54-0216]

And may many of these poor, wondering, straying, children, straying around through the world tonight, without a church home, **grant, Lord, that they'll see their error** and come to the house of the living God.

HEAR YE HIM [57-0725]

And I pray that every sinner, that comes in through these doors, will be converted, and will take a good church-home. There's some fine churches and fine ministers here. And I would not say which one, or where, because if I was here, I'd be in confusion, which place to go. There's just so many fine churches and fine places. And you just take you one of your choice, but be sure to be there every night the door is open. **And if you love the Lord real well, you'll be there. That's one thing, sure.**

THE TIME IS AT HAND [56-0408E]

...**don't stay away from church**; go out to some church and help the fellowship of that church.

JEHOVAH JIREH [57-0612]

...find yourself a good church home and **go to it**, somewhere.

JESUS AT THE DOOR [58-0529] Get you a good church home. **Go to church.**

THE VOICE OF THE SIGN [64-0321E]

We believe that every Christian ought to have a--a home church that they go to. **Every Christian ought to meet somewhere with believers.**

BLIND BARTIMAEUS [57-0809]

...**every person that's saved ought to have a church home. They ought to be in church**, and there every--every time that church has a service, or every time you pass it, go in, open the doors and go in and pray or do something. Love the Lord.

WILL THE CHURCH GO BEFORE THE TRIBULATION? [58-0309E]

If you can't come here, get you a good church home, somewhere, where they really preach the Gospel and so that you can be fed by the Spirit of God.

BALM IN GILEAD [59-0614]

And **I wish this above all things**, that you here tonight, that who believes in your heart that you love the Lord, and something is happened to you, promise me that you'll find a good Gospel church somewhere, a church that teaches the full Gospel, the power of God, His resurrection. Join up with those people and make yourself a church home. Don't just stray around loose on the streets; go get a good church somewhere of your choice, where the Gospel and the power of God is made known, and the signs of Eternal Life is in there, the signs that was in Christ.

DISCERNMENT OF SPIRIT [60-0308]

Every man ought to have a church home. You ought to have a place, not just to float about from pillar to post, but have somewhere that you go to church and you call it your church, somewhere you pay your tithe, and somewhere that you help support the cause. **Take your choice, but then don't never disfellowship the other man because he don't belong with your group.**

THIRSTING FOR LIFE [60-0304]

And this little deer will get out to itself, away from the herd. That's the one the wolf works on. And to you, old man or woman, **when you separate yourself from believers... People say, "I can stay at home, be just as good a Christian as I can at church." You can't.**

The Bible said, *"Not forsake our assemble ourselves together, and that much more as we see the time coming."*

If you're a Christian, you long to go where other Christians are, and fellowship with other Christians. So you cannot stay away from church and live the same life. You--**you can't do it**, because it's like, "I--I--I--I'm hungry, but I'll never go to a table. I just... I'll never eat. I just--I ain't going to do it." See? **You've got to go and feed on the Word of God, and fellowship one with another.**

We need one another--another more now than we ever did need each other, is now. When you get yourself singled out from the rest of them making yourself just a little different, you don't want to associate with them because they believe this, and don't want to associate with that, **you're getting on dangerous ground, right then, keeping away from church.** Find the one of your choice, and remain there, and be a Christian brother to all of them. That's the way to be a real Christian. Then we've got fellowship, protection; people love you and pray for you.
