The Greatest Miracle

EXODUS 14:21-22

21. And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the LORD caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea <u>dry land</u>, and the waters were divided.
22. And the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea upon the <u>dry ground</u>: and the waters were a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left.

NUMBERS 11:18-23

18. And say thou unto the people, Sanctify yourselves against to morrow, and ye shall eat flesh: for ye have wept in the ears of the LORD, saying, Who shall give us flesh to eat? for it was well with us in Egypt: therefore the LORD will give you flesh, and ye shall eat.

19. Ye shall not eat one day, nor two days, nor five days, neither ten days, nor twenty days;

20. But even a whole month, until it come out at your nostrils, and it be loathsome unto you: because that ye have despised the LORD which is among you, and have wept before him, saying, Why came we forth out of Egypt?

21. And Moses said, The people, among whom I am, are <u>six hundred thousand footmen</u>; and thou hast said, I will give them flesh, that they may eat a whole month.

22. Shall the flocks and the herds be slain for them, to suffice them? or shall all the fish of the sea be gathered together for them, to suffice them?

23. And the LORD said unto Moses, <u>*Is the LORD'S hand waxed short*</u>? thou shalt see now whether my word shall come to pass unto thee or not.

NUMBERS 11:31-32

31. And there went forth a wind from the LORD, and brought quails from the sea, and let them fall by the camp, as it were a day's journey on this side, and as it were a day's journey on the other side, round about the camp, and as it were two [cubits] high upon the face of the earth.
32. And the people stood up all that day, and all that night, and all the next day, and they gathered the quails: <u>he that gathered least gathered ten [homers]</u>: and they spread them all abroad for themselves round about the camp.

JEHOVAH OF MIRACLES [59-1126]

Did you realize, dear, how many quails that it would take to feed them people? For there were about two and one half million people in that camp. And each man could easily eat two quail or more, for satisfying. So it would take **more than five million quails**. But He's Jehovah, the Creator. How that He could create quail. There probably wasn't five million quail in all Palestine, or all the wilderness. But He's Jehovah God Who can put them there. JOSHUA 3:17

17. And the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD stood firm on dry ground in the midst of Jordan, and all the Israelites passed over on dry ground, until all the people were passed clean over Jordan.

JOSHUA 10:12-14

12. Then spake Joshua to the LORD in the day when the LORD delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel, Sun, stand thou still upon Gibeon; and thou, Moon, in the valley of Ajalon.

13. <u>And the sun stood still, and the moon stayed</u>, until the people had avenged themselves upon their enemies. Is not this written in the book of Jasher? So the sun stood still in the midst of heaven, and hasted not to go down about a whole day.

14. And there was no day like that before it or after it, that the LORD hearkened unto the voice of a man: for the LORD fought for Israel.

ISAIAH 38:5-8

5. Go, and say to Hezekiah, Thus saith the LORD, the God of David thy father, I have heard thy prayer, I have seen thy tears: behold, I will add unto thy days fifteen years.

6. And I will deliver thee and this city out of the hand of the king of Assyria: and I will defend this city. 7. And this shall be a sign unto thee from the LORD, that the LORD will do this thing that he hath spoken;

8. Behold, I will bring again the shadow of the degrees, which is gone down in the sun dial of Ahaz, <u>ten degrees backward</u>. So <u>the sun returned ten degrees</u>, by which degrees it was gone down.

JONAH 1:17

17. Now the LORD had prepared a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And <u>Jonah was in the</u> <u>belly of the fish three days and three nights</u>.

JOHN 2:5-8

5. His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.

6. And there were set there <u>six waterpots</u> of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing <u>two or three [firkins] apiece</u>.

7. Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim.

8. And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare it.
